1. What data do we collect?

C4D collects the following data:

- a) Personal identification information (Name, address, email address, telephone number, Date of Birth etc.).
- b) For donors to Cycle4Dad we may collect additional information enabling us to collect Gift Aid.

2. How do we collect your data?

You directly provide C4D with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- a) Contact us via one of our web pages (Contact Us, Donate etc.).
- b) Use or view our website via your browser's cookies.

3. How will we use your data?

C4D collects your data so that we can:

- a) Keep you informed of the events we aim to undertake.
- b) Respond to your queries, directed to us, via email or through the website.

4. How do we store your data?

C4D stores your data on password protected standalone PCs owned by the C4D. Some personal data is held securely by our website hosts (Domainit) but this is restricted to very limited personal data **none of which** is deemed to be "sensitive" under the Data Protection Act 2018.

5. Marketing

We DO NOT use any of your data for marketing purposes.

6. What are your data protection rights?

C4D would like to make sure that you are fully aware of all your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access – you have the right to request C4D for copies of your personal data.

The right to rectification – you have the right to request that C4D correct any information which you believe to be inaccurate. You also have the right to request C4D to complete information which you believe to be incomplete.

The right to erasure – you have the right to request that C4D erase your personal data under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing – you have the right to object to C4D processing your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability – you have the right to request that C4D transfer the data that we have collected to another organisation, or directly to you, under certain conditions.

If you make a request we have one month to respond to you. If you would like to exercise any of these rights then please contact us via the email addresses listed on our website (www.Cycle4Dad.com/contactus).

7. What are cookies?

Cookies are text files placed on your computer to collect standard internet log information and website visitor behaviour information. When you visit our website we collect information from you automatically through cookies or similar technology. For further information see www.allaboutcookies.org.

8. How do we use cookies?

C4D uses cookies in a range of ways to improve your website experience including:

- a) Keeping you signed in (if you did so on our secure pages).
- b) Understanding how you use our website.
- c) Building website hit, page hit statistics etc.

9. What type of cookies do we use?

There are a number of different types of cookies, however our website uses:

Functionality cookies – C4D uses these cookies so that we recognise you on our website and remember your previously selected preferences. These could include what language you prefer and the location you are in. Mixes of first-party and third-party cookies are used.

Advertising cookies – C4D uses these cookies to collect information about your visit(s) to our website, the content you viewed, the links which you followed and information about your browser, device and your IP address. C4D **never** shares these data with third parties.

10. How to manage cookies

You can set your browser not to accept cookies and the website www.allaboutcookies.org tells you how to remove cookies from your browser. However in a few cases some of our website features may not function properly as a result. You may also accept cookies but then allow your browser to delete them when you exit the website – this enables the features but ensures that no cookies are retained for subsequent visits to our website.

11. Privacy policies of other websites / organisations

The C4D website contains links to other websites / organisations. Our privacy policy applies only to our website / organisation and we are not responsible for the content, or lack of it, on these sites. If you click a link to another website then you should check their privacy policy.

12. Changes to our Privacy Policy

C4D keeps its privacy policy under regular review and places any updates on this web page. The date of the current policy will be indicated on this web page.
